



**IMMUNIZATION/PHYSICAL EXAMINATION SCHEDULE  
2018-2019**

<b>Entry/Age</b>	<b>Immunizations</b>	<b>Physical Exam</b>
Upon Entry to School	<p>Children enrolling in Rockingham County Public Schools must be immunized and have a physical examination according to current regulations. (Code of Virginia, Section 22.1-270 &amp; Section 22.1-271.2)</p> <p><b>Upon entry to school, child must have 1 dose of each immunization as appropriate for age.</b></p> <p><b>A follow-up plan (appointment date and time) must be given to the school.</b></p>	<b>Evidence of physical exam according to grade level requirements.</b>
Transfer student within Virginia or out of state Grades K-5	<p>Follow required immunizations as per grade level. <u>All non-district transfers must have 4 doses of polio and DTaP, with 1 dose administered after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday and all other age appropriate immunizations.</u></p>	Evidence of physical exam within 12 months prior to the date the pupil first entered kindergarten or elementary school (nurse or principal to determine if a physical exam meets Virginia standards).
Transfer student Within Virginia or out of state Grades 6-12	<p>Follow required immunizations as per grade level. <u>All non-district transfers must have 4 doses of polio and DTaP, with 1 dose administered after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday and all other age appropriate immunizations.</u></p>	No physical examination required.
2 and 3-year-olds	<p><i>Age-Appropriate Immunizations-Per ACIP (CDC) or AAP guidelines.</i></p> <p><b>DTP/DTaP - 4 doses</b>  <b>Polio (all OPV or all IPV) - 3 doses</b>  <b>MMR - 1 dose not earlier than 12 months of age.</b>  <b>Hib - 2 or 4 doses depending on brand given.</b>  <b>Hep. B - (Hepatitis B) - 3 doses</b>  <b>* Varicella/Chicken Pox - 1 dose not earlier than 12 months of age.</b>  <b>Pneumococcal – (PCV) 2 - 4 doses up to 60 months.</b></p>	Evidence of physical exam within 12 months prior to initial admission to school.
4-year-olds	<p><b>DTP/DTaP - 3 doses</b>  <b>Polio (all OPV or all IPV) - 3 doses of vaccine</b>  <b>MMR - 1 dose (after 12 mos. of age)</b>  <b>Hep. B - (Hepatitis B) - 3 doses</b>  <b>* Varicella/Chicken Pox - 1 dose not earlier than 12 months of age.</b>  <b>Pneumococcal- (PCV) 2-4 doses up to 60 months.</b></p>	Evidence of physical exam within 12 months prior to initial admission to school.
<b>Kindergarten and Grades 1, 2, 3, 4 &amp; 5</b>	<p><b>DTP/DTaP - 4 doses, last dose must be received after age 4 – if the child has received 6 doses before the fourth, birthday, additional doses are contraindicated.</b>  <b>Polio (all OPV or all IPV) - 4 doses - 1dose on or after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday. A 4<sup>th</sup> dose is not necessary if 3<sup>rd</sup> dose was at age 4 or older.</b>  <b>MMR - 1 dose (after 12 mos. of age) and 2<sup>nd</sup> MMR or 2<sup>nd</sup> measles (rubeola) and 2<sup>nd</sup> mumps</b>  <b>Hep. B - (Hepatitis B) - 3 doses</b>  <b>* Varicella/Chicken Pox – 2 doses - 1<sup>st</sup> dose not earlier than 12 months of age.</b></p>	<b>Evidence of physical exam within 12 months prior to the date the pupil first entered kindergarten or elementary school.</b>

\* Exemptions will be allowed for those children who have written documentation by a health care provider of a history of chicken pox or of immunity.

Entry/Age	Immunizations	Physical Exam
Grades 6	<p><i>Documentation of Tdap required for entry.</i></p> <p><b>DTP/DTaP</b> - 3 doses, last dose must be received after age 4 – if the child has received 6 doses before the fourth birthday, additional doses are contraindicated.</p> <p><b>Polio (all OPV or all IPV)</b> - 3 doses if last dose was received after age 4, or 4 doses at any age</p> <p><b>MMR</b> - 1 dose (after 12 mos. of age) and 2<sup>nd</sup> MMR or 2<sup>nd</sup> measles (rubeola)</p> <p><b>Hep. B</b> - (Hepatitis B) - 3 doses; if Student has RECOMBIVAX HB 2 doses</p> <p><b>*Varicella/Chicken Pox</b> -2 doses- first dose not earlier than 12 months of age</p> <p><b>HPV</b>- HPV vaccine is required for females. First dose shall be given before child enters <b>6<sup>th</sup> grade. Parent/guardian may elect for the child not to receive the HPV vaccine.</b></p> <p><b>Tdap</b> – booster required for entry into <b>6<sup>th</sup> grade regardless of the interval since the last dose of tetanus-containing vaccine.</b></p>	No physical exam required.
Grade 7 & 8	<p><i>Documentation of Tdap required for entry.</i></p> <p><b>DTP/DTaP</b> - 3 doses, last dose must be received after age 4 – if the child has received 6 doses before the fourth birthday, additional doses are contraindicated.</p> <p><b>Polio (all OPV or all IPV)</b> - 3 doses if last dose was received after age 4, or 4 doses at any age</p> <p><b>MMR</b> - 1 dose (after 12 mos. of age) and 2<sup>nd</sup> MMR or 2<sup>nd</sup> measles (rubeola)</p> <p><b>Hep. B</b> - (Hepatitis B) - 3 doses; if Student has RECOMBIVAX HB 2 doses</p> <p><b>*Varicella/Chicken Pox</b> – 2 doses-First dose not earlier than 12 months of age.</p> <p><b>Tdap</b> – booster required if not received prior to entering 6<sup>th</sup> grade</p>	No physical exam required.
Grades 9, 10, 11 & 12	<p><i>Documentation of Tdap required for entry.</i></p> <p><b>DTP/DTaP</b> - 3 doses, last dose must be received after age 4 –if the child has received 6 doses before the fourth birthday, additional doses are contraindicated.</p> <p><b>Polio (all OPV or all IPV)</b> - 3 doses if last dose was received after age 4 or 4 doses at any age.</p> <p><b>MMR</b> - 1 dose (after 12 mos. of age) and 2<sup>nd</sup> MMR or 2<sup>nd</sup> measles (rubeola)</p> <p><b>Hep. B</b> - (Hepatitis B) 3 doses; if student has RECOMBIVAX HB- 2 doses</p> <p><b>*Varicella/Chicken Pox</b> – All students born on or after 1/1/97 are required to have 1dose, not earlier than 12 months of age.</p> <p><b>Tdap</b> – booster required if not received prior to entering 6<sup>th</sup> grade.</p> <p><b><u>Note: Only 1 dose of Tdap is required even if it has been more than 5 years since the Tdap was given.</u></b></p>	No physical exam required.

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
